Join us for a day-long field tour of the Montney Formation analogues in the Kananaskis area. The tour, led by Dr. Jon Noad and AGAT Labs, will examine multiple stunning outcrops deposited during the Lower Triassic period.

The Montney Formation, located under a wide region of Alberta and British Columbia, is one of the most active and prolific oil and gas formations in the Western Canada Sedimentary Basin. Estimated to contain approximately 449 trillion cubic feet of natural gas, it is said to be one of the largest natural gas resources in the world. The AGAT field school tour will start in Calgary and includes in depth discussion

during the bus ride to the first stop. From there, we will take you through a hands on tour of the deposition, stratigraphy and geologic evolution of this world class reservoir. This exciting and fun filled tour includes transportation, meals and in depth discussion on the significance and history of each of our 6 stops throughout the base of the Rockies. Professionals can also include the trip as a day of continuing education.
